***Unintentional drowning death is defined as accidental drowning and submersion (ICD-10 codes W65–W74):**

- W65 Drowning and submersion while in bathtub
- W66 Drowning and submersion following fall into bathtub
- W67 Drowning and submersion while in swimming-pool
- W68 Drowning and submersion following fall into swimming-pool
- W69 Drowning and submersion while in natural water, Include: lake, open sea, river, stream
- W70 Drowning and submersion following fall into natural water
- W73 Other specified drowning and submersion. Include: quenching tank, reservoir
- W74 Unspecified drowning and submersion, Include: drowning NOS, fall into water NOS.

Excluding:

Accident to watercraft causing drowning and submersion (V90), and water-transport-related drowning and submersion without accident to watercraft (V92), intentional self-harm by drowning and submersion (X71), assault by drowning and submersion (X92), and undetermined intent of drowning and submersion (Y21).
