¹¹Two part question asked: For 2 weeks or longer during your most recent pregnancy did you feel sad, empty or depressed for most of the day? and For 2 weeks or longer during your most recent pregnancy did you lose interest in most things like work, hobbies, and other things you usually enjoyed? Respondents who answered "yes" to either questions were coded as having "Self reported depression."

¹²Question asked: Overall, how satisfied were you with the support given by your baby's father during your pregnancy? Respondents who answered "Somewhat dissatisfied" or "Not at all satisfied" were coded as "Dissatisfied with support given by the baby's father."

¹³Question asked: During your last pregnancy, did the baby's father do any of the following for you? Hit or slap you when he was angry.

¹⁴Question asked: During your last pregnancy, would you have someone to loan you \$50 if you had needed it?

¹⁵Question asked: How would you rate this neighborhood in terms of its safety from violence? Respondents who answered "Very good" or "good" were coded to "Perceived neighborhood as safe."
