SUBJECT: LA COUNTY CCS CHILDREN - ENROLLMENT IN MEDI-CAL MANAGED CARE

As you may know, under the provisions of SB 208 (Ch.714, 2010), seniors and persons with disabilities (SPDs) are to be mandatorily enrolled into Medi-Cal Managed Care Organizations (MCO). This is to inform you that the State of California's Department of Health Care Services (DHCS) has determined that **Medi-Cal beneficiaries who are CCS clients and who are assigned an SPD Medi-Cal aid code will NOT be mandatorily enrolled into a Medi-Cal MCO.** This rule will remain in force until further instructions are provided by the State relative to the implementation of the CCS Demonstration Projects. After the demonstration pilot projects have been selected/awarded, and CCS children are enrolled, mandatory enrollment for CCS clients with an SPD eligibility code will be implemented in counties that are not included in a CCS Demonstration Project service area and in which a Medi-Cal MCO is operational.
