

Vacancy Announcement

Senior Physician – STD Controller

The Los Angeles County (LAC) Department of Public Health (DPH) is seeking candidates to fill this vacancy in the Division of HIV/STD Programs (DHSP). Los Angeles County is one of the largest local jurisdictions in the U.S. and requires innovative and targeted approaches to effective HIV/STD disease control. DHSP is a large public health division within the Department of Public Health with an annual operating budget of \$100 million and over 310 staff positions and is responsible for coordinating the County's overall response to the local HIV and sexually transmitted disease (STD) epidemics. DHSP conducts a wide range of HIV and STD-related activities including disease surveillance and epidemiology, support and oversight of HIV/STD prevention and treatment programs, and a large portfolio of research and evaluation projects to inform the planning and delivery of HIV/STD services in Los Angeles County. DHSP facilitates and guides the investment of approximately \$70 million in contracted programs and services to more than 80 distinct County-based, community-based, and university-based entities throughout LAC who support our organizational mission.

POSITION SUMMARY:

The Senior Physician will serve as the STD Controller for DHSP and join a team of highly skilled and energetic clinicians, researchers, epidemiologists, and administrators to inform, guide, and maintain a progressive response to STD and HIV in a large, racially-diverse county with urban, suburban, and rural designations. The STD Controller leads the development and execution of county-wide STD prevention and control strategies and programs that are evidence-based and that consider the social, structural, and environmental conditions that influence STD-related morbidity among Los Angeles County residents.

KEY RESPONSIBILITIES

- Design and implement, in coordination with county and community partners, STD prevention and control initiatives;
- Serve as LAC DPH's resident STD clinical expert and be responsible for a broad range of STD-related clinical quality assurance and quality improvement activities for STD partner services and DPH's 11 STD clinics;
- Oversee the delivery of STD medical consultations and trainings for public and private-sector providers;
- Prepare and, in consultation with the DHSP Medical Director, approve STD data analyses, slide-sets, presentations and papers for public dissemination and consumption;
- Serve as liaison to the California State STD Control Branch and Centers for Disease Control and Prevention (CDC) on STD related topics of public health importance; and
- Liaise with peers and community stakeholders, including through the development of written summaries and verbal presentations; and
- Provide direct patient care in a County STD clinical care setting 1-2 days per month.



Los Angeles County offers its employees a comprehensive and competitive benefits package. Starting salary for the position is dependent on qualifications, specialty, and salary history.
