To foster collaborative efforts to prevent vaccine preventable diseases.


## GUIDING PRINCIPLES

**Advocate** for health policies that will improve immunization coverage levels and reduce health disparities for infants, adolescents, and adults.

**Foster** creativity and respect for diverse ideas.



## STRUCTURE

**Constituency:** A public/private partnership of Los Angeles County schools, hospitals, clinics, pharmacies, vaccine companies, managed care health plans, and local health department programs.

**General Meetings:** Participants meet three times a year to share information on best practice approaches to improving immunization coverage levels, vaccine-preventable disease surveillance updates, as well as advocacy/policy updates at the national, state, and local levels.

**Workgroups:** Participants volunteer time to collaborate on community-based projects to increase immunization coverage levels for infants, children, adolescents, and adults.

**Steering Committee:** Participants from diverse organizations volunteer time to serve in a leadership capacity on ICLAC's decision-making body.



## PRIORITIES

**Build** ICLAC's infrastructure by expanding leadership roles among ICLAC participants.

**Provide** relevant and effective programs and activities for the ICLAC partnership.

**Strengthen and sustain** active participation of strategic partners in ICLAC activities.
