- Provide consultation to social workers and probation officers regarding health care resources and guidance in prioritizing health needs for the children.
- Provide joint home visits with the Children's Social Workers in DCFS as needed.
- Provide consultations to social workers regarding health care resources and guidance in prioritizing health needs for children in foster care.
