## VACANCY ANNOUNCEMENT PUBLIC HEALTH NURSE

The <u>People Experiencing Homelessness - Public Health Nurse</u> (<u>PEH-PHN</u>) in SPA 6 & 8 promotes healthy people in healthy communities and sets out to advance the conditions that support optimal health and well-being of SPA 6 &8 residents. PEH-PHN works under Clinic Services Division, the Mobile Vaccine Team to develop and implement activities in line with clinic services and Public Health goals. The PEH-PHN implements activities that promote more robust outreach and engagement efforts targeting homeless encampments that are identified to have high health risk concerns.

#### The duties and responsibilities of the position include but are not limited to:

- Participate in community programs and collaborative partnerships that focus on creating healthy communities and a better quality of life for individuals experiencing homelessness
- Provide outreach, referrals, education, support, linkages, care coordination and case management services as appropriate for outreach team clients who need assistance managing health conditions
- Provide field-based services and trauma-informed care to chronically homeless adults with seriousmental illnesses, substance use disorders and/or physical health problems and addresses psychosocial needs for persons experiencing homelessness
- Lead field vaccination efforts for PEH during respiratory season and in response to identified outbreaks among this population
- Provide homeless resources and Public Health Nursing expertise to internal and external stakeholders

### **MINIMUM QUALIFICATIONS:**

- A license to practice as a Registered Nurse and a Public Health Nurse Certificate issued by the California Board of Registered Nursing
- A valid California Class C Driver License
- Must currently hold the payroll title of a Public Health Nurse for lateral transfer or be on a reachable PHN list

#### **DESIRABLE QUALIFICATIONS:**

- Ability to work with persons experiencing homelessness
- District PHN and PEH case management experience
- Strong Interpersonal skills, self-motivated and flexible
- Ability to work independently and as a team member
- Strong problem-solving skills
