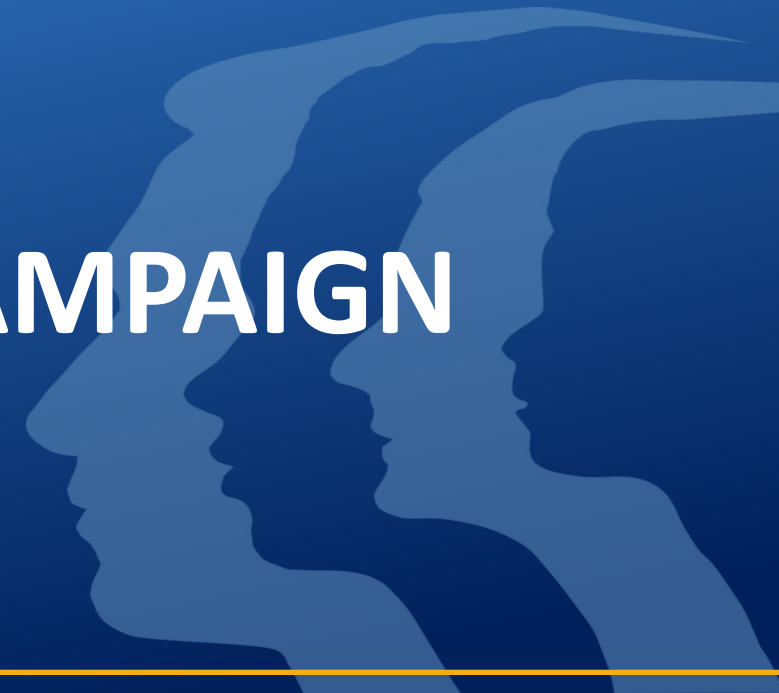

# UPCOMING SUD AWARENESS CAMPAIGN



## PURPOSE

**EXPAND AWARENESS, REDUCE STIGMA, AND INCREASE KNOWLEDGE** of SUD and recovery options, including harm reduction and treatment.

## AUDIENCE 1

### **FRIENDS/FAMILY/COMMUNITY**

Individuals close to someone struggling with or at risk of developing an SUD. Those who are unaware they have an SUD.

## AUDIENCE 2

### **INDIVIDUALS WITH SUD**

Those struggling with SUD and need support/treatment. Those who have not sought treatment for whatever reason (95%).

# Overdose Prevention and Response Training and Technical Assistance

## GOAL:

To support Provider networks' ability to offer overdose prevention and education services to individuals services at their facilities.

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## Activities:

- Focused on overdose prevention, response, and harm reduction in treatment facilities
- Trainings encompass a range of activities that support effective overdose prevention education and in the distribution of overdose prevention kits.
- **All treatment providers MUST participate in this training**
- Technical assistance on developing/updating protocols will also be offered, as needed

- ❖ **DO NOT** use fentanyl test strips to test patients
- ❖ **OPRTTA team** will contact you to discuss how to distribute
- ❖ **Track** distribution

- ❖ **Two (2)** 4mg doses of Naloxone Nasal Spray
- ❖ **Two (2)** Fentanyl Test Strips
- ❖ **Printed materials**
  - Good Samaritan Card
  - Naloxone Prescription Card
  - Fentanyl precaution card & Instructions
  - Overdose First Aid Manual
