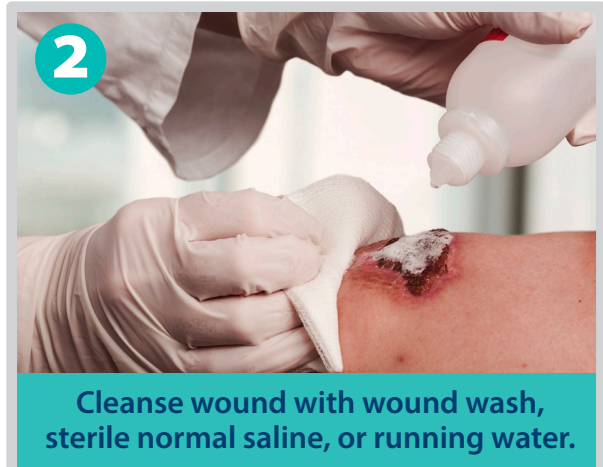


# Recommended Wound Cleaning Steps



Xylazine, or Tranq, is a veterinary tranquilizer that is being cut into illicit drugs, powders, and counterfeit pills. It can cause severe wound infections, increase overdose risk, and make opioid-overdose reversals more difficult.

# Signs of a Wound Infection



White, yellow, green, gray, or black tissue

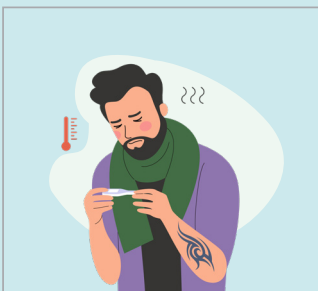


Heavy pus or oozing fluid or foul odor

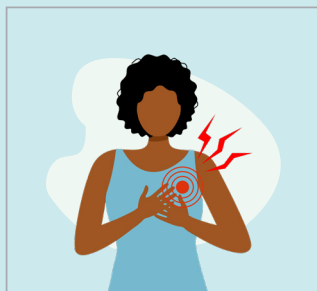


Loss of sensation, severe pain or reduced range of motion

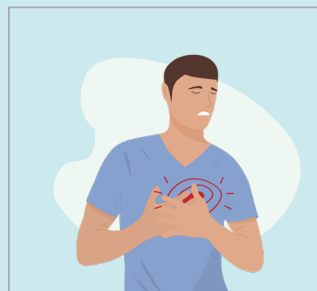
## Serious Symptoms of a Body-wide Infection or Emergency



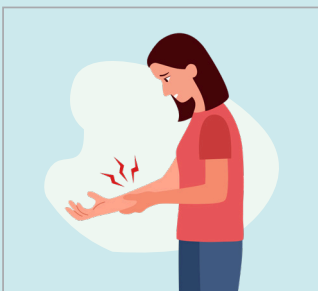
Fever



Chest pain



Difficulty breathing or fast shallow breathing



Numbness, tingling, or loss of sensation



Dizziness or lightheadedness



Weakness



Confusion
